This service will be led by Merseyside Domestic Violence Service, (MDVS) in partnership with Change Grow Live (CGL). The service has been funded by a grant from the Home Office (PCC).

The service is available across Liverpool and St Helens for **CONVICTED and High-Harm, Serial PERPRETRATOS**. The purpose of the programme is to work in partnership with CGL so that we together can identify and address issues that escalate domestic abuse, such as alcohol and substance misuse.

This is a **referral-based** programme and will deliver a 6-month programme of support and interventions for male perpetrators and female ex/partners.

Communications across multi-agency stakeholders will be open and regular.
